Introduction



The second international independent art festival "Sea level" is dedicated to 20-year anniversary of non-state, non-commercial art-center "Pushkinskaya-10".

The name of this festival is its slogan rather than its theme. Why "Sea level"? The world's great civilizations, whose culture has influenced our times, had arisen and flourished on the seashore.

People's well-being depended on the tide. Sea level fall uncovered the shelves abundant in marine products, giving life and wealth, while sea level rise along with storms flooded the cities, bringing disaster and death. It can be said that sea level was happiness level.

Saint-Petersburg has been founded in 1703 on the shore of the Baltic Sea in order to open the marine ways from Russia to other countries of the world. A zero point for measuring sea level and height of Earth's surface has been marked in 1777 on the Kotlin Island in the Gulf of Finland. It was named "foot-gauge".

For those willing to participate in the festival we announced an international art project competition. Our invitation was accepted by many artists, musicians, writers, photographers, and media artists from 68 cities and 27 countries of the world. From 224 presented projects 12 ones were chosen by festival jury. The main criteria was the project's conceptual integrality.






Представленные три работы являются частью особой серии абстрактной живописи, которая проявляется в различных уровнях и глубине – как Море.


Море взяло много жизней во всех водах, не только моряков и рыбаков. И многие их родственники нашли утешение в церкви. Символ для церкви и религии — специальное витражное окно с различными цветами и светом. Жизнь и религия — больше чем цвета и свет, там появляется темнота и тени. Свет обозначает надежду. Мы не любим, когда напоминают об этой темноте. Иногда вы встречаете поверхности, которые являются довольно сырыми и почти уродливыми. Но позади темной поверхности вы иногда находите свет.

Three works of arts are from a special series of abstract paintings. The special abstract paintings appear in different levels and depth — like the Sea. The sea took many lives in all, not only seamen and fishermen. Many relatives found consolation in church. A symbol for the church and the religion is the special window of glass with different colours and light. Life and religion is more than colours and light, there is dark and there are shadows. The light stands for the hope. What's dark we don't like to be reminded of. Sometimes you meet surfaces which are rather raw and almost ugly. But behind the dark surface you sometimes find some light.
